## Fire Safety Emergency Kits

---

- **First aid materials.** Include prescription medications, over-the-counter painkillers, rubbing alcohol, eye wash kit, bandages, latex gloves, antiseptic spray and vomit-inducing medication, in case of accidental poisoning.
- **Battery-operated radio.** To listen to warnings, evacuation orders and notifications.
- **Flashlight and extra batteries.** In the event that the power is out.
- **Cash.** Do not depend on ATMs if the power is down.
- **Dry clothes and good shoes.** For each of your family members, in the event of an evacuation.
- **Sleeping bags and tent.** In the event of an evacuation or lack of sufficient shelter.
- **Personal hygiene.** Include toilet paper, hand towels, feminine products, toothbrush, toothpaste, hand sanitizer and, if there is a young child, diapers.
- **Pet supplies.** Food and a leash, if necessary.
- **Whistle.** To signal and direct attention if you are caught in a fire.
